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Bilingual Certification: Students who earn a 3 or higher on the Spanish Language AP exam are certified as bilingual.

Academic Support Programs: The following programs are housed on our campus and assist our students in various capacities when applying for college, seeking financial aid, etc. We partner with San Jose Cal-SOAP, Destination College: Advising Corps., TRiO, and iMentor.

Fire Service Magnet Program: Since 2013, the Fire Service Program graduates receive CPR certification and EMT Test Preparation. This program prepares students who have a career goal in the medical, fire, or emergency service areas. It requires leadership



training and community service hours. It is not college preparatory.







Silicon Valley Career Technical Education: Silicon Valley Career Technical Education educates eligible high school students for success in careers and college in a professional, hands-on environment. Courses are Career Technical Education offered within 11 industry sectors



where junior and senior high school students can explore and develop technical skills that will lead them to higher education or into the workplace.



Athletic Participation: James Lick is a member of the Blossom Valley Athletic League, Santa Teresa, and West Valley Divisions.

Project-Based, Interdisciplinary Learning: Beginning with the 2014-2015 school year, all classes are now taught in the project-based and problem-based learning model. Our students have developed 21st-century skills through our innovative, interdisciplinary courses that combine a variety of subject matters.
