

### San Jose Police Department Chief's Scholarship Program Sponsored by the San Jose Police Foundation

The San Jose Police Foundation and San Jose Police Department in 2018 established a scholarship program to assist qualified San Jose students in their pursuit of higher education. To date, more than \$50,000 has been granted to 12 students.

For 2022, the following scholarship opportunities are available:

Chief's Scholarship Award, \$2,500 annually

Awarded to a San Jose student who has overcome challenges, had exposure to the San Jose Police Department as an offender and/or has been in juvenile detention, but has exhibited an obvious change in behavior and is recommended by a law enforcement professional, social worker or social services or non-profit agency. Cumulative GPA of 2.8 or higher.

Karolyn Kirchgesler Memorial Scholarship, \$2,000 one-time

Karolyn was a dedicated board member with the San Jose Police Foundation and the CEO of Team San Jose, who passed away in 2020. She was an energetic leader, an animal lover and an inspiration to young women and girls. This scholarship will be awarded to a female student leader with a clear interest in leadership and high career aspirations. Requires a cumulative GPA of 3.4 or higher.

William Del Biaggio, Jr. Memorial Scholarship, \$2,000 one-time

Bill was a founding member of the San Jose Police Foundation and a longtime business leader who was beloved in San Jose. This scholarship will be awarded to a student with an interest in community service, who takes volunteerism seriously, is rooted in San Jose and is successful academically with a cumulative GPA of 3.4 or higher.

#### All applicants must:

- Be a San Jose resident
- Attend high school in San Jose
- Have a demonstrated financial need.
