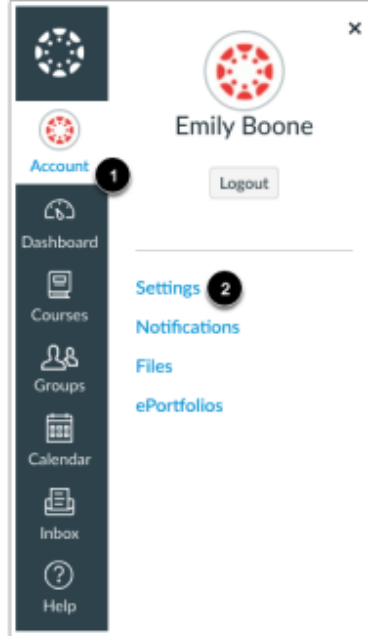

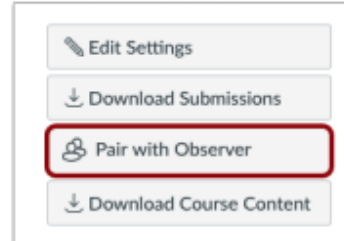

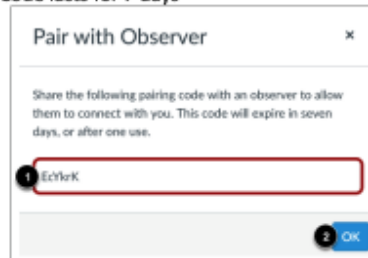

How do you earn your High School Diploma from James Lick High School?

James Lick High School (JLHS) academic year runs from August 10 to June 1, 2022. The academic year is divided into 2 semesters. 1st semester is from August 10 to December 23, 2022. 2nd semester is from January 9 to June 1, 2023. If a student earns a grade of A, B, C, or D, at the end of each semester, they will earn 5 credits for that semester. If they earn a grade of F, they will earn 0 credits. In total, a student must earn 220 credits* to earn their high school diploma. The chart below will explain the required courses that are needed to earn their 220 credits.

El año académico de James Lick High School (JLHS) se extiende del 10 de agosto al 1 de junio de 2022. El año académico se divide en 2 semestres. El primer semestre es del 10 de agosto al 23 de diciembre de 2022. El segundo semestre es del 9 de enero al 1 de junio de 2023. Si un estudiante obtiene una calificación de A, B, C o D, al final de cada semestre, obtendrá 5 créditos para ese semestre. Si obtienen una calificación de F, obtendrán 0 créditos. En total, un estudiante debe obtener 220 créditos para obtener su diploma de escuela secundaria. La tabla a continuación explicará los cursos requeridos que se necesitan para obtener sus 220 créditos.*

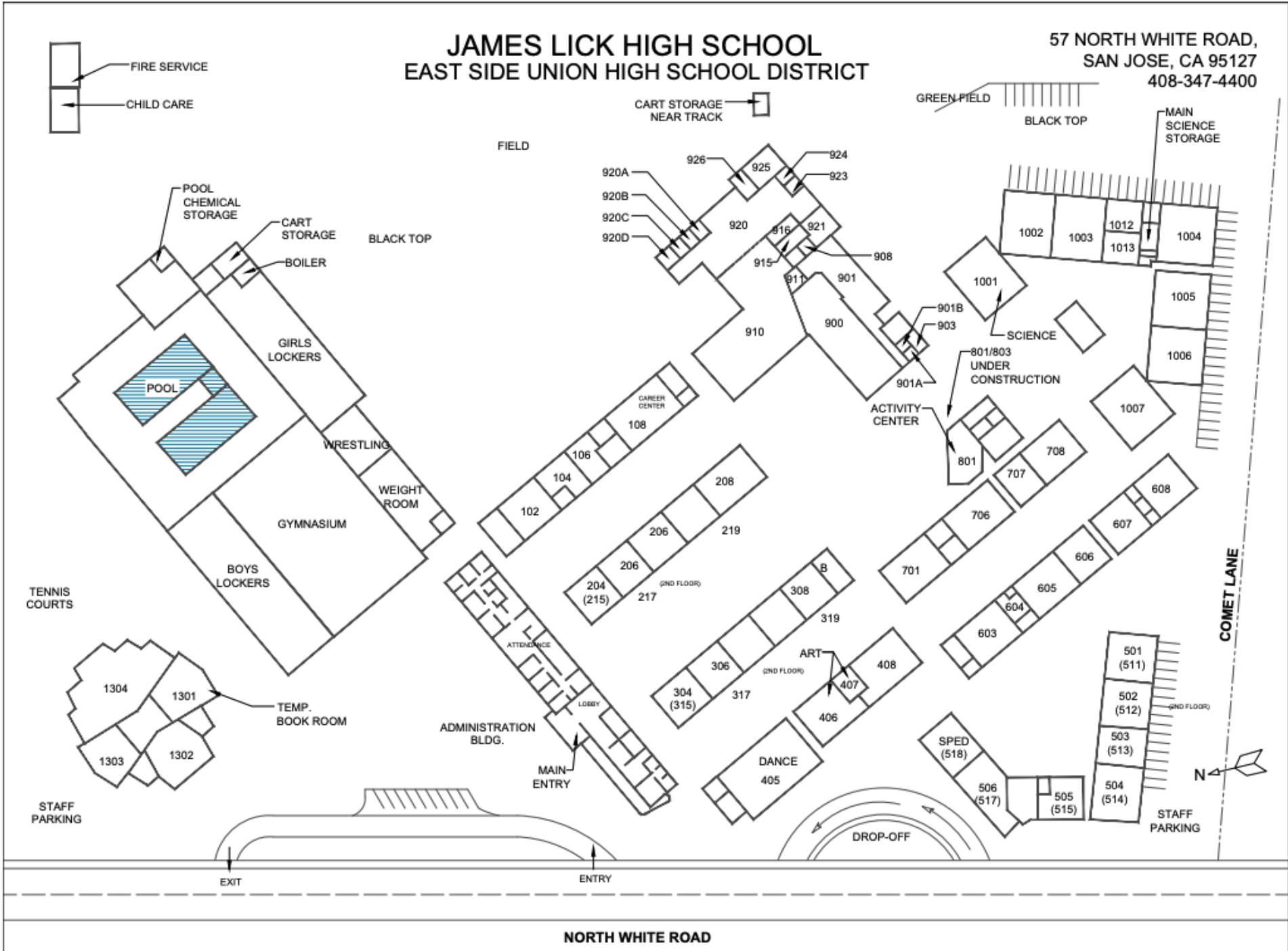
